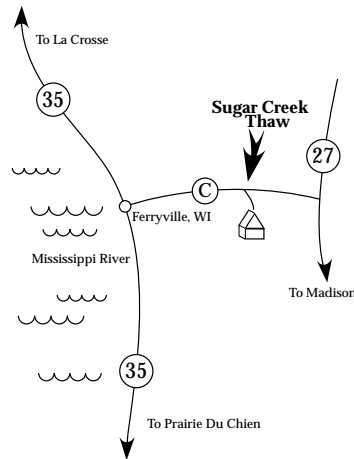

## Sugar Creek Thaw - April 28th

Welcome to the Sugar Creek Thaw Mountain Bike Race! Once again it is time to think about mountain bike racing. And what better way to get that taste and feeling back into the system than by participating in the Sugar Creek Thaw. The natural landscape of western Wisconsin's coulees and bluffs provide this area with ideal mountain bike terrain.

**Course:** The Sugar Creek Thaw race course lives up to this potential and promise. It is an awesome mix of rolling doubletrack, sweet singletrack, technical sections, small creek crossings, hard climbs, and fast downhill. And for the second year running, the course includes Greg's Plank-of-Truth. It is easy to see that this course has something for everyone—from beginner to expert and from geared to single-speed riders.



**Location:** All of this is 45 minutes south of La Crosse. From Hwy. 35, drive five miles east on County C. The race site will be on your right. Or from Hwy. 27, drive three miles west on County C. The race site will be on your left.
